

Using Public Transit in the Park

Paddling, splashing, biking, or hiking: Getting around the Delaware Water Gap National Recreation Area has never been easier with public transit. The Monroe County Transit Authority (a.k.a. Pocono Pony) provides free access to Smithfield Beach, boat launches, and recreational trails on the PA side of the Delaware Water Gap National Recreation Area on weekends and holidays from Memorial Day through Labor Day. Pocono Pony buses and trailers also provide portage for patrons to load their equipment, up to 10 kayaks or canoes and 4 bicycles.

Flag Stops

The system is designed to enable riders to board the bus at just about anywhere along the route. Simply wave to the driver from a safe and observable location. Remember to be at the bus stop 5 minutes before the scheduled time.

ADA Accessibility

All Pocono Pony buses are ADA accessible. However, they are not offroad vehicles. Many areas of the park may not be accessible. MCTA vehicles may divert up to 3/4 of a mile off route, if approved by an MCTA official, 1 business day prior to travel. Please call MCTA at (570) 243-3400 for more information.

National Park Service Fee Areas

Transportation and portage services are free to the public in the park. Visitors who enter "expanded amenity fee" areas via private vehicle are charged \$10 per vehicle. Visitors entering "expanded amenity fee" areas riding the bus will not be charged.

Three Shuttle Routes

Riders can catch the Delaware Water Gap Connector at four convenient locations and stay on board for the River Runner, DWG Hiker Shuttle, or Raymondskill Falls Shuttle. Parking is extremely limited at Kittatinny Point. However, free parking is available at the Park and Ride in Delaware Water Gap, located across from the PA Welcome Center off exit 310 from I-80.

The **Water Gap Hiker Shuttle** will transport passengers from the Kittatinny Point and Dunnfield Creek back to the Park and Ride. No portage service available on this shuttle. The last shuttle leaves Dunnfield Creek promptly at 5:40 PM and can only accommodate 16 passengers. If the shuttle is full or has departed, you can follow the Appalachian Trail over the I-80 bridge to Delaware Street, then on to Main Street in Delaware Water Gap. Turn right onto Broad Street and the Park and Ride will be on your left. The NPS or MCTA will not provide transportation after the last shuttle has departed.

The NPS or MCTA is not responsible for any unattended equipment.

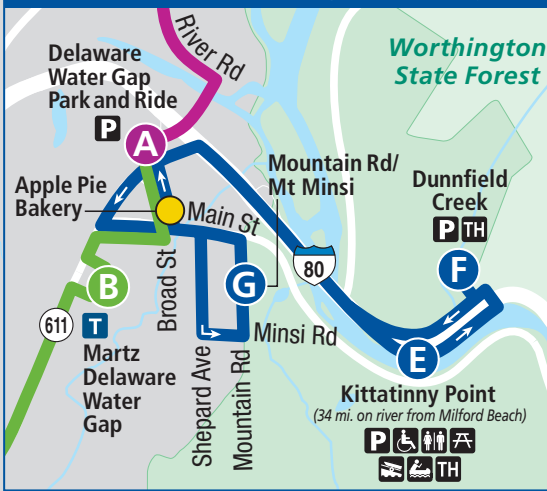

Take the River Runner north from the DWG Park and Ride to your put-in point and use the Water Gap Hiker Shuttle or hike the Appalachian Trail to retrieve your vehicle after you arrive at Kittatinny. Use the above schedule to plan your trip back to DWG Park and Ride.
